Because of your continued support in 2018 we could continue and expand every program we have in place and enter new opportunities. Your generosity made it possible to provide 157,748 meals in 2018; 101,748 meals plus snacks locally and 56,000 meals globally to our friends in Haiti!! God continues to show up!!

Here is a breakdown of how and where these meals were provided:

#### Weekly Local Weekend Backpack Meals

- Deliver meals to schools in Adrian, Blissfield, Britton, Clinton, Hudson, Morenci, Onsted, and Tecumseh.
- 570 – students served weekly during the school year.
- 2,280 meals provided each week.
- 68,520 total backpack meals provided in 2018

#### Local Christmas/Spring Break Meal Packs

- 447 Christmas Break meal packs delivered to students throughout Lenawee (14,304 meals)
- 358 Spring Break meal packs delivered to students throughout Lenawee (6,444 meals)

#### Summer Meals Program

- Provided weekly meal packs to 30 children in the Lenawee Migrant Head Start summer program.
- Provided weekly meal packs to 20 children in the Blissfield Migrant Program.
- Partnered with the LISD to provide weekend meal packs to students throughout the county that attend the LISD Summer Literacy Programs.
- Deliver weekend meal packs to the Boys and Girls Clubs in Adrian and Hudson.
- In total; provided 12,480 meals to school aged children throughout Lenawee County during Summer Break

#### Hope Community Center

I92 provides snacks for the Hope Center in Adrian to help fill in gaps where snacks are needed throughout the day. The center has 30-50 people attend daily.

#### Haiti Meal Packs

We had three separate Haiti Meal packing events. With the help of hundreds of volunteers, we packed and shipped 56,000 bean and rice meals to our partner organization in Haiti; Mission of Hope-Haiti

In 2018 we surpassed 400,000 total meals provided since we began in 2012.

By the grace of God, we met three of the goals we identified for 2018.

1. We had a need for space to operate from and in August 2018 we moved into a location that will serve us well. Centrally located in the county on Sand Creek Hwy. and 223 in Adrian we are in a great location to serve the county.
2. We were ready to expand our weekly meal pack program and added Morenci Elementary School and the Boys and Girls Clubs in Adrian and Hudson. These additions added 192-children to our weekly program.
3. Because our distribution is so closely tied to the schools we had a void in our reach during the summer months. We had the opportunity to partner with the LISD to provide meal packs to students that attend their Summer Literacy Program. This enabled us to reach children in 7-school districts during summer break. The partnership with the LISD and addition of the Boys and Girls Club provided us an opportunity to make an impact in kid's lives over summer break.
4. We packed 56,000 bean and rice meals for our partner in Haiti; Mission of Hope – Haiti to help with their nutritional program. Our goal was to pack and ship 100,000 meals; we will continue to strive to meet or exceed that goal this year.

Our goals for 2019 include:

- Add one or two schools to our weekly backpack program.
- Serve additional schools in the LISD Summer Literacy program to have a larger impact in the summer months.
- Pack and ship 100,000 bean and rice meals to Mission of Hope-Haiti.
- Expand our monthly sponsorship program to support students in our weekly backpack meal program.

God only know what He has in store for us in 2019. I'm excited to see where He leads us and the doors He opens for us. May He be glorified in everything we do!
